Role Profile – Expert Consultant

Role Overview:

The Expert Consultant will provide technical and research support for the GREENMEDPORTS Project at the Port of Aqaba, Jordan. And he will contribute to project implementation, technical studies, and capacity-building activities throughout the project's duration.

Main Tasks:

- 1. Provide technical guidance to Prepare a Technical Report outlining the existing data collection and monitoring frameworks for the engaged ports, providing a solid baseline for project activities.
- 2. Specify the **framework conditions and evaluation tools** for the **Carbon Footprint Platform (CFP)** to ensure consistent and comparable implementation across pilot sites.
- 3. Supervise the Development of the CFP in a controlled environment before its deployment under real port conditions.

- 4. Support the **design and implementation of site-specific Pilot Actions**, preparing detailed reports summarizing outcomes, milestones, challenges encountered, and lessons learned.
- 5. Oversee the deployment of the Pilot solution (multidisciplinary innovation hub for green transition) at the Port of Aqaba, ensuring alignment with project objectives and real operational conditions.
- 6. Provide guidance and build **capacity in scenario analysis, policy development, and decarbonization strategies** for stakeholders involved.
